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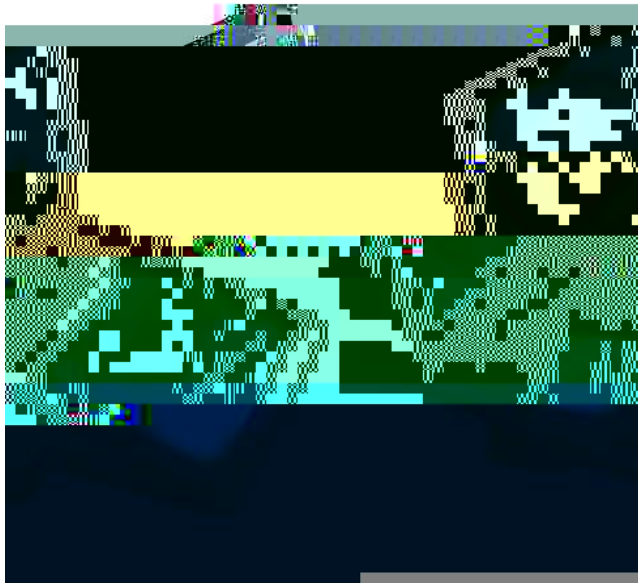
1.1.Introduction

1.3. How do I use it?



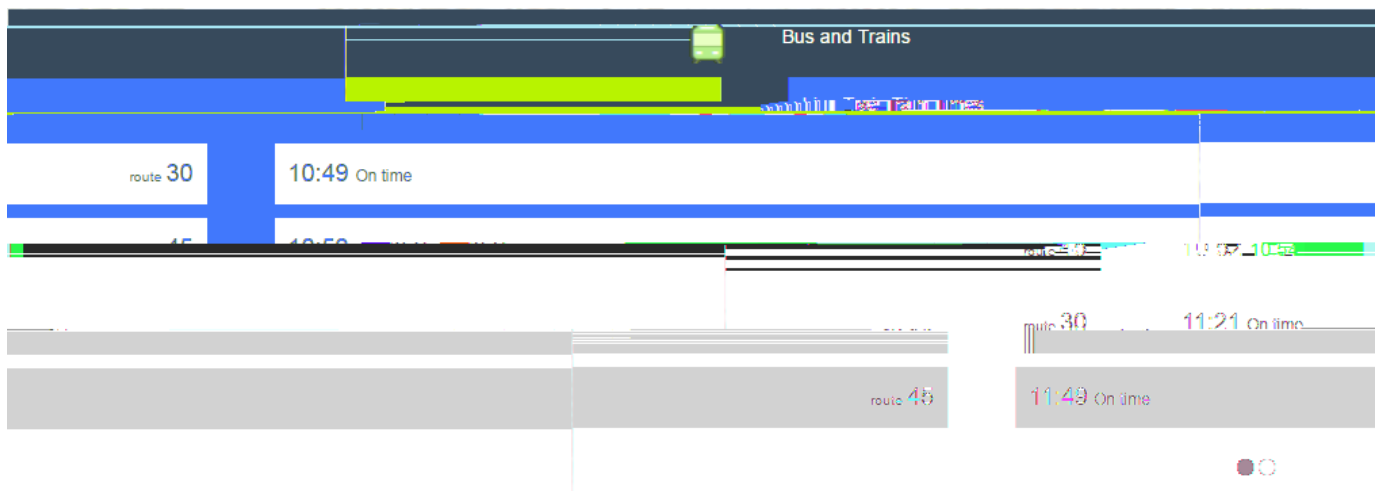
Our newly re-created Student Portal has been built to be as compatible with any device you may wish to use it with.

The Student Portal works great on both a mobile device, a laptop or tablet. It will auto resize itself to the full width of any screen you may be using utilizing a technology called “Responsive Design”

Once you have logged into the Student Portal your personalised selection of functionality will be displayed in a variety of modules (or boxes), each holding a different categorized piece of information or functionality.

When using a mobile device or tablet, wherever you find two dots on module (or box), you can swipe left using your finger or thumb to find more information contained within this module. If you are using a desktop or laptop, you can click on the greyed out “dot” icon to perform the same functionality.

3.3. Course Details

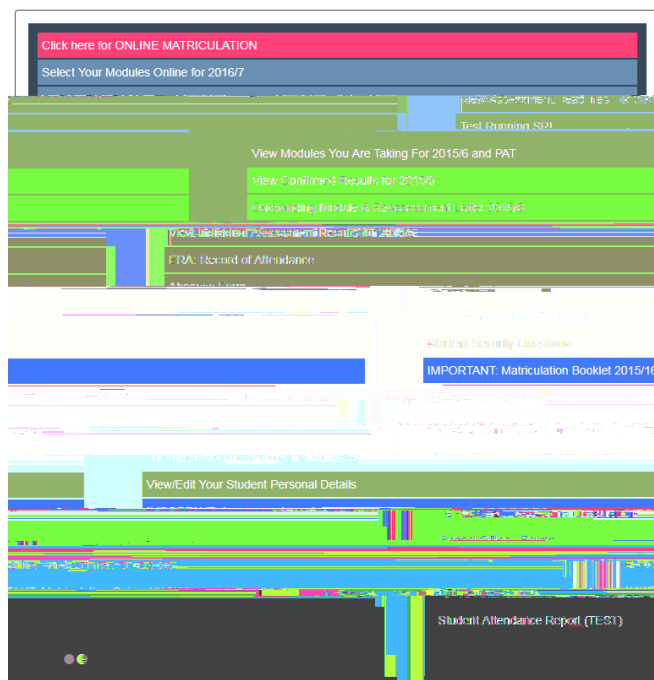

A reminder of your course details and matriculation status.




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All your main functions, online matriculation, pick your modules, see your results.



3.4. Travel


Live bus times, and live train times. Keep an eye on the next bus leaving the campus or delays on the busses and trains. The route numbers are also clickable and produce a route map.

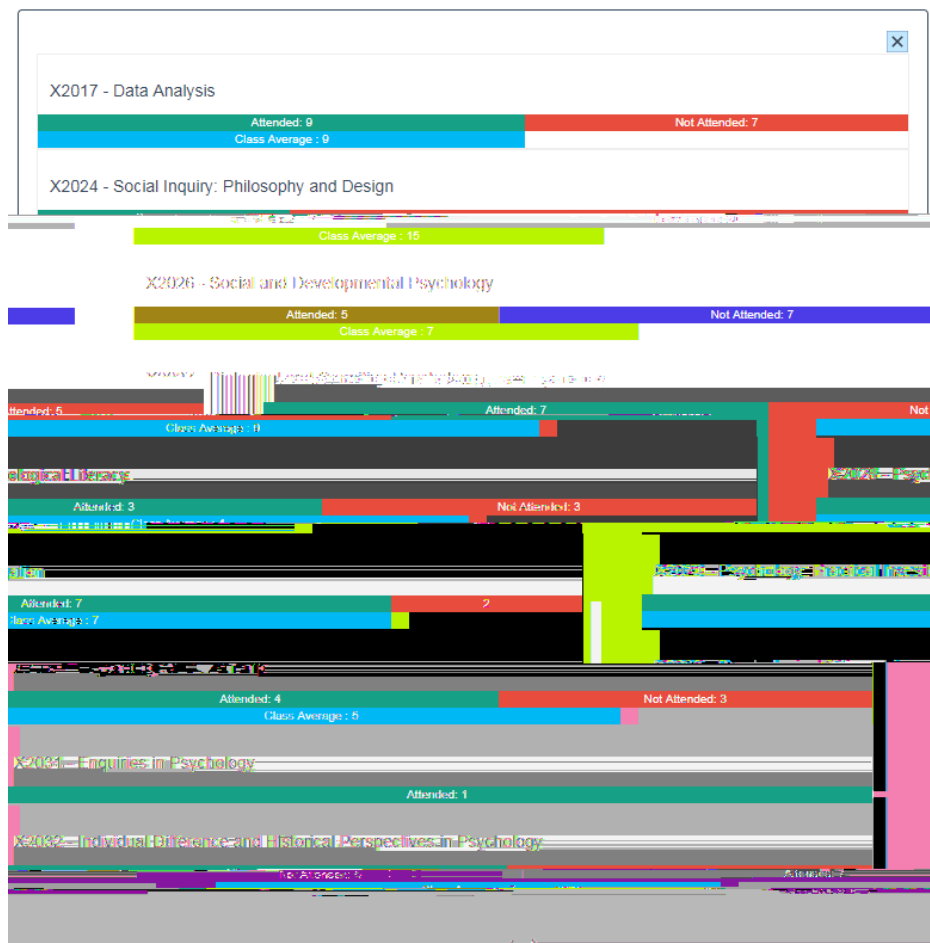
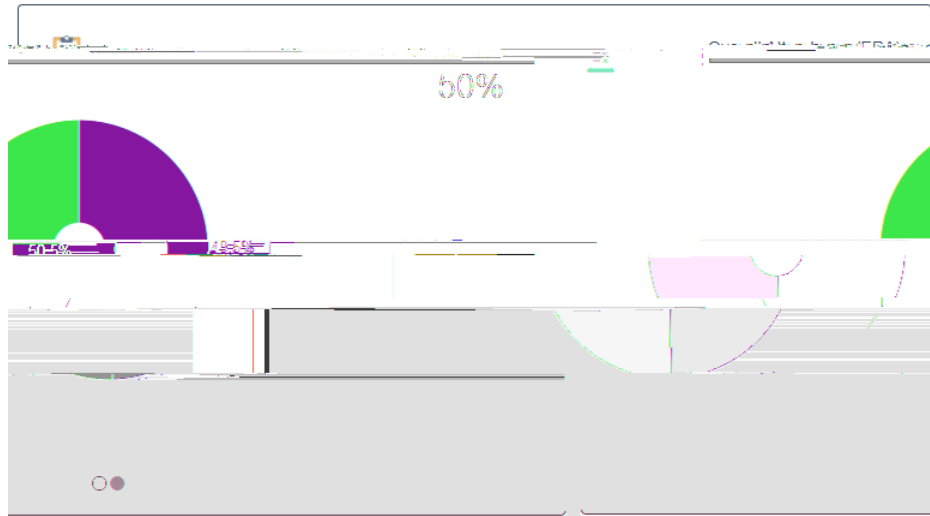
